- Oral and maxillofacial aesthetics to smooth skin around your beautifully created smile
- Establishing aesthetic dental lip lines and smile lines to aid in smile designs and aesthetic dentistry
- Adding lip and perioral volume around the mouth to aid in the retention of removable prosthodontics
- Oral and maxillofacial aesthetics, including lip augmentations and replacing volume in the intra-orally and extra-orally
- Off licence recreating interdental papillae where volume lost
- Improving class II skeletal appearance.
